DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply only as directed. Apply during the growing season. Andersons Golf Products Turf Fertilizer 11-0-22 supplies a high level of potassium from potassium sulfate for soils low in this nutrient. Adequate potassium levels help promote root development and resistance to stress.

Application Rates:

LOW RATE:	4.55 lbs./1,000 sq. ft.
MEDIUM RATE:	6.82 lbs./1,000 sq. ft.
HIGH RATE:	9.10 lbs./1,000 sq. ft.

For all applications:

- Apply to dry foliage.
- Water in after application with a minimum of 0.2 inches to help move particles into the turf canopy.
- Do not collect clippings for at least one mowing following application to avoid particle pick-up.

Cool Season Grasses:

- Apply at the LOW RATE late spring and summer every 4-6 weeks.
- Apply at the MEDIUM RATE early spring and fall.

Warm Season Grasses:

- Apply at the MEDIUM RATE late spring and summer every 4-6 weeks.
- Apply at HIGH RATE early spring and fall.

STORAGE AND USE

Store in a clean, dry place.
Reseal opened bag by folding top down and securing.
Use only in clean, dry spreaders.
Do not leave unused product in spreaders.
