Apply only as directed during the growing season. Do not use on putting greens. Do not use with a drop-type spreader. All of the nitrogen in this product is provided by Extend™.

Application Rates:

LOW: 2.3 lbs/1,000 sq. ft.
MEDIUM: 2.8 lbs/1,000 sq. ft.
HIGH: 3.5 lbs/1,000 sq. ft.

For all applications:

- Apply to dry foliage.
- Water in after application with a minimum of 0.2 inches to help move particles into the turf canopy.
- Do not collect clippings for at least one mowing following application to avoid particle pick-up.

Established turf:

Cool Season Turf:

- Apply at the MEDIUM RATE every 3-4 months during the period of active growth.
- Apply at the HIGH RATE in spring or fall.
- Exception: Apply at the LOW RATE when temperatures exceed 80°F.

Warm Season Turf:

- Apply at the MEDIUM RATE every 3-4 months during the period of active growth.
- HIGH RATE may be used in early spring to help bring grasses out of dormancy (such as bermudagrasses).
- Exception: Apply at the LOW RATE when temperatures exceed 90°F.

Recent research has shown that well-maintained turf is an effective environmental buffer that prevents pollutants from entering our natural water bodies.
