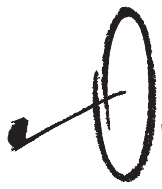

LOW: 2.22 lbs/1,000 sq. ft.
MEDIUM: 4.44 lbs/1,000 sq. ft.
HIGH: 6.70 lbs/1,000 sq. ft.

For all applications:

- Apply to dry foliage.
- Water in after application with a minimum of 0.2 inches to help move particles into the turf canopy.
- Do not collect clippings for at least one mowing following application to avoid particle pick-up.

Cool Season Grasses:

- Apply at the LOW or MEDIUM RATE.
- Exception: Apply at the LOW RATE when temperatures exceed 80°F.

Warm Season Grasses:

- Apply at the MEDIUM or HIGH RATE.
- Exception: Apply at the MEDIUM RATE when temperatures exceed 90°F.

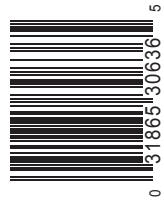
