DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply only as directed during the growing season. Use on greens, tees and low-cut fairways as a source of phosphorus, potassium, calcium, and magnesium for enhancing turf tolerance to stress caused by aeration or to help correct phosphorus and/or potassium soil deficiencies.

APPLICATION RATES

Light:	2.75 lbs./1,000 sq. ft.
Normal:	5.5 lbs./1,000 sq. ft.

For all applications, apply on dry foliage and water in immediately with a minimum of 0.2 inches of water for optimum results.

Apply at the Normal Rate two weeks prior to aeration to allow time for turf response and to aid for faster turf recovery OR apply at the Normal Rate, after aeration, as a last step following topdressing.

Use anytime additional phosphorus and potassium are needed according to a soil test.

Use the Light Rate during summer days where temperatures are 85°F or above.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a clean, dry place. Reseal opened bag by folding top down and securing. Use only clean, dry spreaders. Do not leave unused product in spreaders.
