FOR TURFGRASS

Use as a fungicide in the prevention and control of the listed soil-borne diseases which attack turfgrass on golf courses, home lawns, institutional, ornamental, and recre-

ational areas where fine turf is under a maintenance program. Do not use for turf "Leaf Spot" or "Dollar Spot" in California.

DISEASES CONTROLLED

- Brown Patch (*Rhizoctonia solani*)
- Leaf Spot (*Drechslera (spp.)**)
- Dollar Spot (*Sclerotinia homoeocarpa*)*
- Gray Snow Mold (*Typhula spp.*)
- Pink Snow Mold (*Microdochium nivale*)

*Do not use in California.

For best results use as a preventive application before diseases appear, or apply at the first sign of the infection. If heavy rainfall or flooding occurs after treatment or if disease is severe or reappears, treat area again. Follow the rates and comments as listed below for control of turfgrass diseases. **NOTE: Apply the high rate when disease is severe and use low rate when disease pressure is light.** Treated area should be watered lightly as soon as possible after the application to wash the fungicide down to the soil level.

DISEASE: Brown Patch (*Rhizoctonia solani*)
HOST: St. Augustine, Bermuda and similar warm-season grasses.
AMT./GALS WATER PER 1,000 SQ. FT.:
 16-24 fl. oz in 1 to 5 Gals. of water/1,000 sq. ft.
HOW AND WHEN TO APPLY: Apply once in spring or fall or when disease appears. If it reappears, re-treat 3 to 4 weeks later.

DISEASE: Brown Patch (*Rhizoctonia solani*)
HOST: Dichondra
AMT./GALS WATER PER 1,000 SQ. FT.:
 16-24 fl. oz in 5 to 10 Gals. of water/1,000 sq. ft.
HOW AND WHEN TO APPLY: Apply once in spring or fall or when disease appears. If it reappears, re-treat 3 to 4 weeks later.

DISEASE: Brown Patch (*Rhizoctonia solani*)
HOST: Bluegrass, Rye, Fescue, Bent & similar cool-season grasses.
AMT./GALS WATER PER 1,000 SQ. FT.:
 5-6 fl.oz./ in 1 to 5 Gals. of water/1,000 sq. ft.
HOW AND WHEN TO APPLY: Apply at first sign of disease. Repeat every 7-10 days during warm damp weather.

DISEASE: Leaf Spot (*Drechslera spp.*)*, Dollar Spot (*Sclerotinia homoeocarpa*)*

HOST: All Turf Grass Species

AMT./GALS WATER PER 1,000 SQ. FT.:

11-16 fl.oz./in 1 to 5 Gals. of water/1,000 sq. ft.

HOW AND WHEN TO APPLY: For preventive measures apply in spring or fall of each year. If disease is present apply at 16 fl. oz rate as soon as possible. If disease is severe or reappears, re-treat area 3 to 4 weeks later.

*Do not use in California.

DISEASE: Gray Snow Mold (*Typhula spp.*), Pink Snow Mold (*Microdochium nivale*)

HOST: Cool Climate Grasses

AMT./GALS WATER PER 1,000 SQ. FT.:

12-16 fl.oz. in 1 to 5 Gals. of water/1,000 sq. ft.

HOW AND WHEN TO APPLY: First treatment should be made prior to first snow fall.

Do not graze treated areas or feed grass clippings to live-stock. Under certain growing conditions, a temporary discoloration of the grass occasionally may occur. This causes no harm and will disappear in a short time.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

STORAGE: Store product in its original container in a cool, dry locked place out of reach of children. Protect from temperatures below 35°F.
